		Tripping		Staff	Medium	• Ensure that stand is kept tidy and orderly at all times and, that boxes and other materials are cleared from the serving area.
		Serving of samples	Germination of spores; bacterial growth and cross contamination	Customers	Low	 All products can be stored/served at ambient temperatures and need no preparation. Ensure all sampling equipment (plates and pourers) are regularly cleaned to ensure cross contamination does not occur. Samples of chocolates to be handed out on a clean plate. Keep good personal hygiene and ensure antibacterial hand and surface wipes to be available at all times. Samples of 1 cl of alcohol to be served in a 1 oz plastic sample cups, pourer on bottle to control amount of alcohol. Food products (chutney and truffles) given on clean (unused sample sticks. Allergens poster to be displayed on the stand with the products associated with. All staff briefed of allergens present in products.
		Samples of alcoholic products	Being in breach of Licensing laws	Staff	Low	 Ensure staff are trained on the licensing laws, and specifically who we can and cannot sample/sell our products to. (Not to those under the influence of alcohol) Using the "Challenge 25" scheme, displaying posters and training the staff to ID anyone they think looks under 25.
		Fire Risk		Staff/Cust omers	Low	No sources of ignition being used on the stand. 2kg powder fire extinguisher will be available.
